



# Population: Study Area vs Rest of Boston




Nearly one half of the Boston population lives in the study area.

And the area is predominantly residential in character with schools, churches, small businesses and community development organizations.








## **City's Total Black Population**














#### **EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT**






#### **SCHOOL ENROLLMENT**






# MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME

INCOME & BENEFITS (IN 2010 Infl-Adjd. \$s)













#### Foreclosure Petitions by Neighborhood - 2009

Problems of foreclosure lead to serious impacts on the well-being of the household.






#### Adults Who Think Their Neighborhood is Safe, 2008




#### Infant Mortality, 2006, 2007, and 2008 Combined

Most of Roxbury, Dorchester and Mattapan have the highest rates of hospitalization for heart disease.






#### Diabetes Hospitalizations - 2007, 2008, and 2009 Combined

has the highest rates for parts of Roxbury and Roslindale. Moreover, rest of RPC study area makes the second rank.







